

Many of our arts pioneers are still active and contributing members of those city hall shows and shows at the MACC (Mills Station Arts & Culture Center).

It all started with the question, "Where are the arts in Rancho Cordova?" Little did Linda Nunes know that she was going to spark a movement.



Cordova Community Council (Shelly Blanchard) brought this to the attention of the city and the Art at City Hall was born.

## Origin Story, continued

Now 11 years later we are still hosting 4 shows a year at city hall (three themed, and one open show in the fall).

Recognizing that culture and the arts make a city where people want to move to, visit, and spend money, the city council has focused initiatives within Rancho Cordova to drive the arts. You have an opportunity to help shape that vision, and we need your involvement.

While the art at city hall was the catalyst for the arts, the MACC has been the driver for the past 5 years. Now in its sixth year, the MACC is busier than ever with concerts, artist talks, workshops, documentary movies, and much more. Shows like "Righting a Wrong: Japanese Americans and WWII" from the Smithsonian this February and March help to put the MACC and Rancho Cordova on the map as a culturally significant city.

This year Rise Up Theater will open its own theater near KP International

Market at the end of the year making it our 2nd a theater location to focus on the performing arts, along with Cal Cap Film Studio. The 10.5 acres across from the MACC will start breaking ground in late 2024 or early 2025. This project has 31K square feet of arts space.





# **2nd Annual California Capital International Documentary Film Festival in September**

The 2nd Annual California Capital International Documentary Film Festival will take place on Saturday, September 30 and Sunday, October 1st in Rancho Cordova.

The festival will take place at three screening locations: Rancho Cordova City Hall Council Chambers and The American River Room, 2729 Prospect Park Drive, Rancho Cordova, CA 95670, and Cal Cap Black Box Theatre, 9845 Horn Road, Sacramento, CA 95827.

The official selections for the festival will be announced on June 26, 2023, on the **festival website**, www.calcapdocfest.org. This year's program includes over 90% of films selected from the festival's open call, with submissions coming from 43 nations. The documentaries explore a wide range of themes including, art, politics, portraits, poverty, social issues, homelessness, sports, environmental crisis, war, world traditions, and the dynamic nature of our changing world.

The festival aims to provide an international program to local audiences and will feature screenings in cinematic 6k with surround sound. The Mills Station Arts and Cultural Center (MACC) will serve as the festival Hub for networking and filmmaker discussions.
