We started passing out panels in January 2023 at intake for the first Art at CityHall show. Slowly throughout the spring we handed out 368 six-by-six inch panels to Rancho Cordova Arts Members and other artists around the area. May was the first drop off, which, as the receiver, is like getting Christmas presents in spring (even though they are not for me).

As the little jewels came in, show Chair Edith LeFebvre, photographed all the work and uploaded it all to the 32auctions.com website. This was a giant undertaking, so thank you Edith, you are a board member extraordinaire!

The bidding started at 8 am on a Monday morning, and within 30 minutes bidders are already logging on to "heart" their favorites to bid on, and the race began. These five days were a marathon not a sprint, and many bidders will tell you they have a strategy. On the first three days of the Members' Show you could see the gems in-person. We had 429 pieces of art in our auction this year which is the most we have ever had. Clearly the audience approved greatly of the pieces that all our artists submitted because we broke our record. The online auction totaled \$15,001.67 and that didn't count our donation of \$2,500 from the Creative Arts League Sacramento.

We will let you know when the supplies are coming in and the date for the pickup party for the teachers. Good Day Sacramento will come out – and we would love to have you there as well.

- Most pieces purchased by one patron was 15
- Single piece sold for the highest price was \$320
- Buyers got us to \$150% of our goal!



This summer Josh Hoover, Assemblymember from District 7 (covering Rancho Cordova, Fair Oaks, Gold River, Citrus Heights, Mather, Folsom, and part of Carmichael) has allowed Rancho Cordova Arts members to showcase a small amount of work in his Folsom office. The art hangs in his office for about 3 months, and then we switch it out. I send out requests for the art via our membership portal, and if you are interested you can send me a picture of a few (3-5) pieces. I will tell you which ones to bring in and when to take them to his office. We hope that more businesses around the Rancho-Gold River area decide they would like to host artists in their places of business. Exposure is great for artists, and the business benefits as well.

There is no commission taken by the businesses. The artist makes one hundred percent of their asking price. So watch for emails; there are more art in public places opportunities coming. The 5th Annual Members Show July 2023

Another milestone for the books

This was the 5th year Rancho Cordova Arts has had their Members' Show at the MACC. This year we had 65 artists and 121 pieces of art. This was, as many people commented, the best Members' Show yet. Great music from the Stellis Trio filled the gallery, wine and fine food was consumed as 177 guests attended the artist reception. Unfortunately, we were experiencing some record heat during the show, so our Klipptones Concert night was cancelled due to extreme weather. During the three-week run the show was seen by a total of 328 guests. Pieces of art found new homes, and our Micro Masterpieces filled the center of the upstairs with participants getting eyes on their future purchases.

Each year the Members' Show (usually in June) is a great chance to show your best work and meet many of the other members. This year's reception was perfect from a gallerist's point of view. Enjoyable conversations about the art, community, and the amazing live music transported guests to make you think you were at a NY art exhibit opening. Even if you don't have art in a show, think about coming and supporting those who do, and be engaged and possibly inspired by what you hear and see while there.

Building an art community takes both those who do art, and those who just love to enjoy it. Be a part of our community here at the MACC and Rancho Cordova Arts. Plan to attend and have your art in next year's Members Show, June 6-22, 2024.






